




There were no class Queen and Prince Charming as we didn't have a carnival.


To the Freshmen and Sophomores, we leave all our worn-out books, pencils, combs, and tennis shoes.

Sports

During 1954-'55, the sports activities have been centered around basketball. This season has been the most successful in the history of the Chadwick Cardinals.

We were entered in three invitational tournaments and the sub-regional, winning two trophies.

At the Clever invitational tournament we defeated Spokane by a score of 72-51 in the first game. Then we upset Republic in the second 56-54, but in the semi-finals we were defeated by Greenwood 81-66. In the third place game we over ran Strafford by the score of 81-67.

At the Springfield Tournament of Champions we played Joplin and were defeated 61-40.

In the Branson Tournament we defeated Exeter in the first game. Then in the quarter-final game we edged Hurley 41-40. In the semi-finals we whipped Forsyth 60-38, but in the finals we were defeated by Branson 70-45.

The Subregional Tournament was held at Nixa. In the first game we defeated Nixa. 46-39. In the second game we met the powerful Branson team and were defeated 67-34.

The Cardinals were defeated only once this year on their home floor. The team which marred this record was Winona by the score of 69-68. The season's record is 18 wins and 5 losses. Gary Rozell and Jon Payne were elected Captain and Co-Captain.




