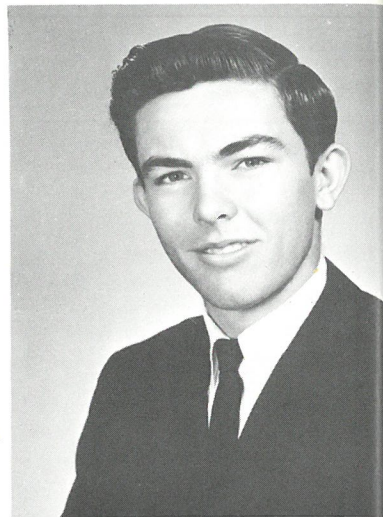
.....my.....MA...A...A...A.....!!!
