

On January 22, 1970 Mr. W. O. Ingle passed away after suffering from a heart attack.



We the students of Chadwick lost a good Superintendent as well as a good friend. We enjoyed his lively stories and the advice he would give us at anytime we walked into his office.





This is the first year we students have made posters for Homecoming. Each class made one, and then the posters were judged. The class receiving first prize for the best poster was awarded a three dollar check.








