Marc was a Junior at Chadwick High School, was on the honor roll and president of his class. He was also a member of the basketball, baseball, and track teams. He was manager of the volleyball team and active in all school activities.

He was killed instantly at the scene of an automobile accident at Chadwick, Missouri on March 22, 1972.

In his eleven years at Chadwick School he established many friendships and was known for his congeniality, understanding, and sense of humor by all his classmates. He was known to his teachers for his dependability, reliability, and good scholarship.

We wonder why one who indicated such a great possibility for future usefulness was taken so early in life.

I was just as mean to him as he was to me. I hurt him, too. I gave him something he didn't expect to get. Cancer. If he can do that to me, I can do that to him. He didn't know I had feelings, too. He doesn't know what it is like to be treated like dirt.

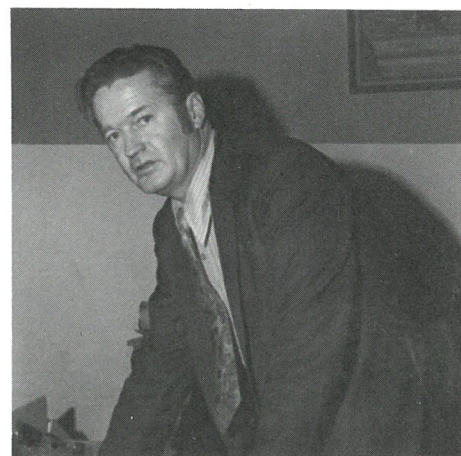
Someday he is going to wish he hadn't done this to me. But for now he doesn't care. He's probably got a brother or sister of mine right now...
