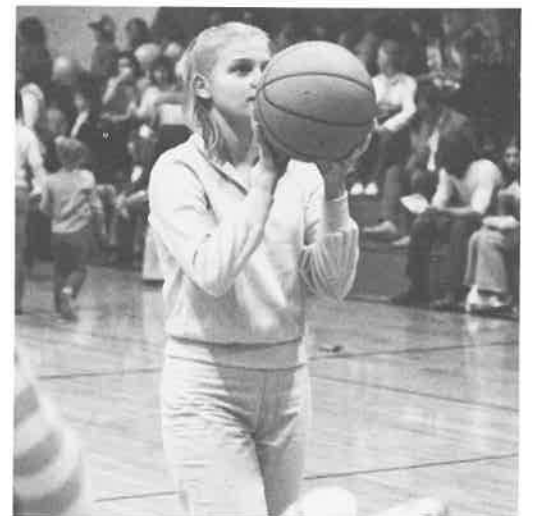
## EXCITEMENT

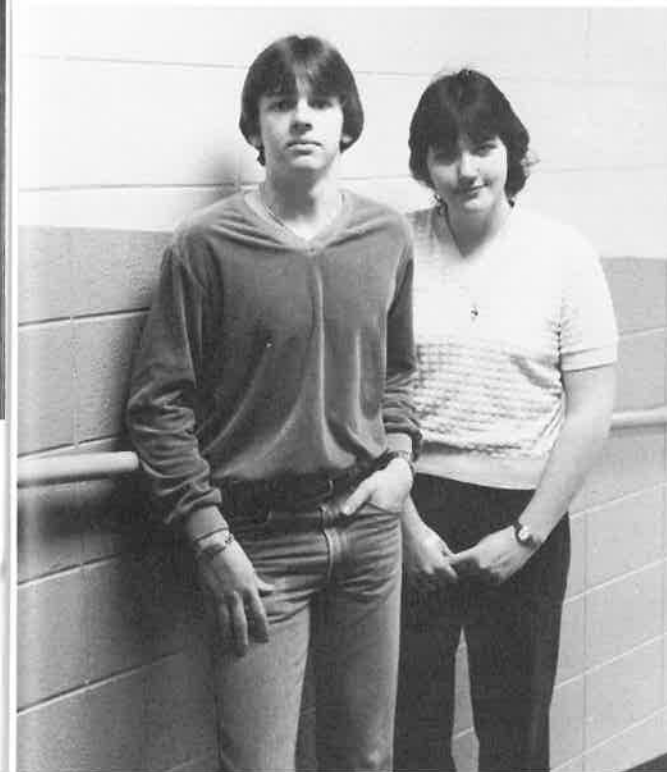

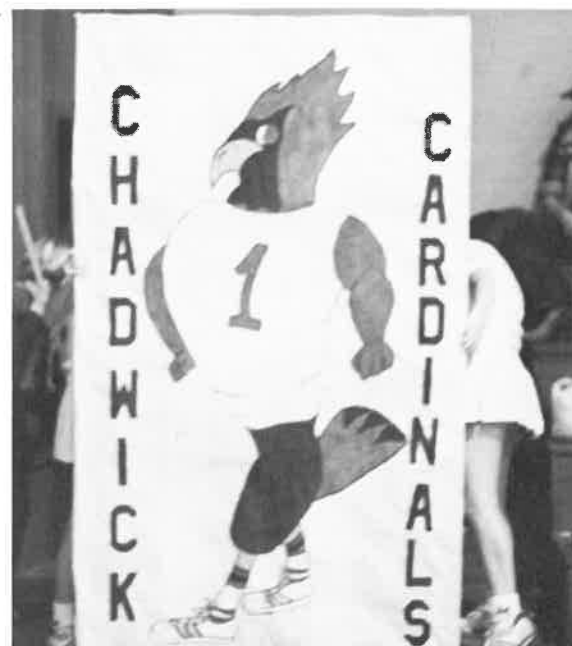


### HOMECOMING
