

the U.S. do. They may go shopping, see a movie, bowling, or they go to parties.


In Japan, Tomomi lives with her mother, father, sister, grandpa, grandma, and uncle. Tomomi's father works in a major department store, while her mother is a government official.

The Yearbook and Newspaper Staff organized and published three newspapers this year and the 1992-93 Chadwick Show-Me Yearbook.



When asked about the season most of the teammates said it was a good year but there were times when you would think you were watching two different basketball teams one would show up to play and the other would just show up.





Mr. Joe Mease, the principal at Chadwick School for the last nine years retired at the end of the 1992-93 school year.


