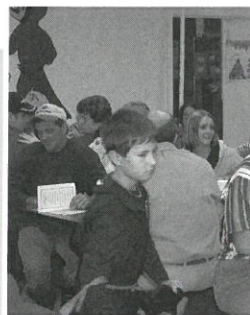


Fall Festival: Free Food & Fun

Parents and community members were given a chance to talk to the architects about the proposed building projects. The architects also helped raise community awareness regarding the bond issue.



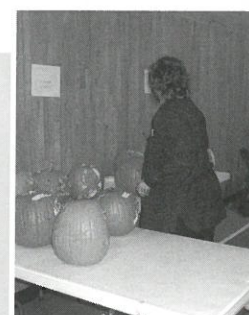

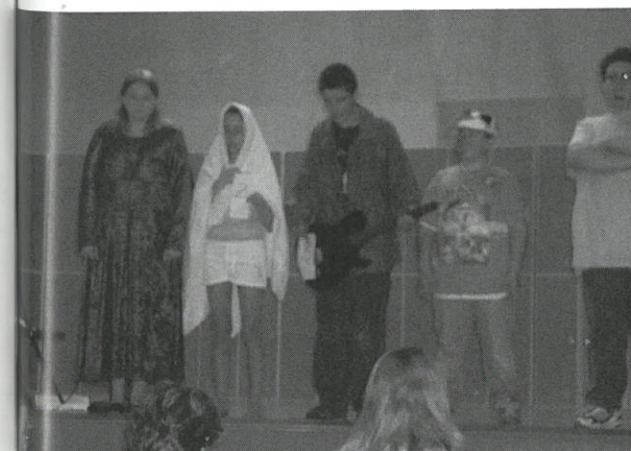

Classrooms in the junior high area will be upgraded.

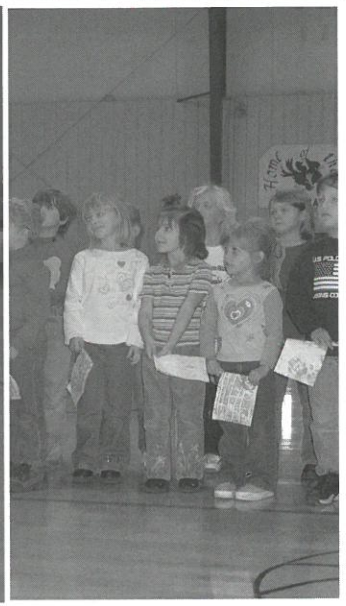
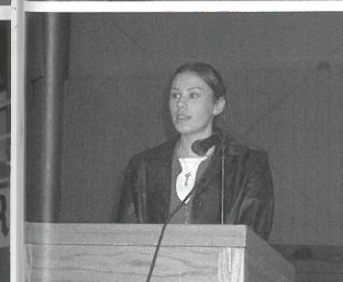
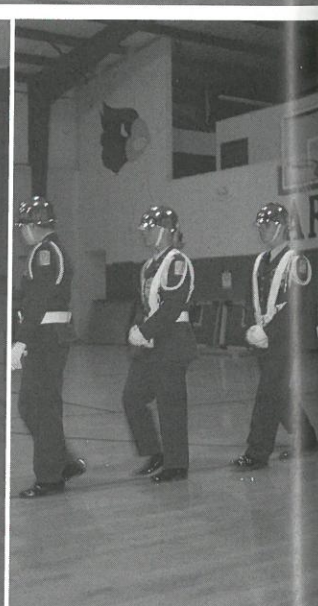
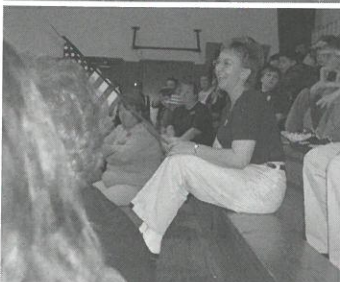
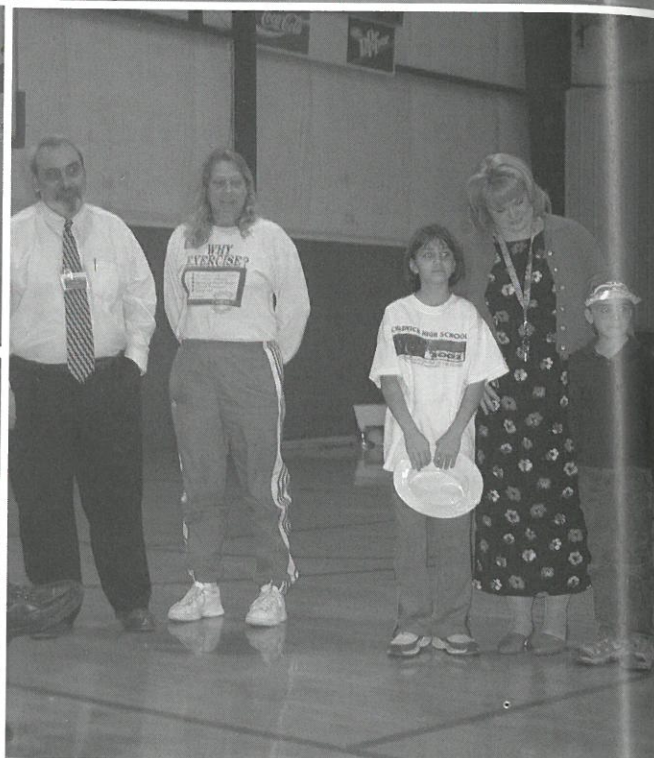
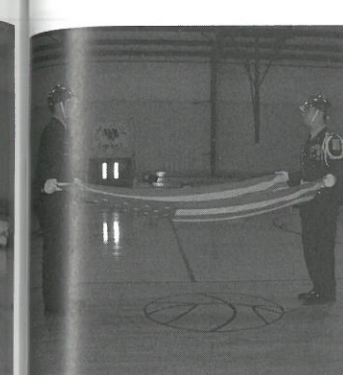
The construction project will begin in late spring or early summer of 2003. They hope to finish by the end of the 2003-2004 school year.
