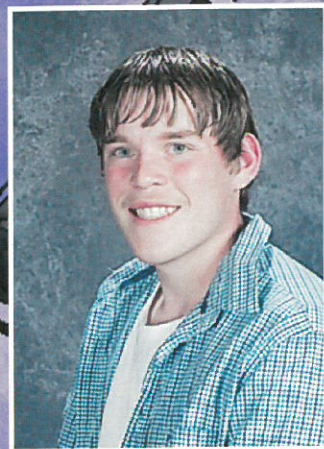
### In Memory of Brianna Lynn Walker
