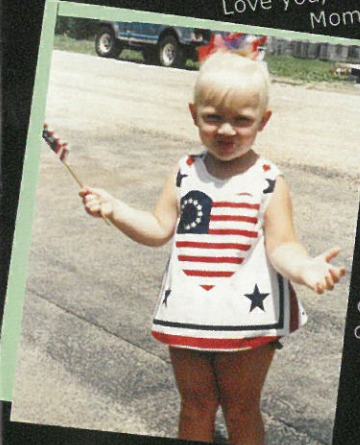


Dear Misty,
