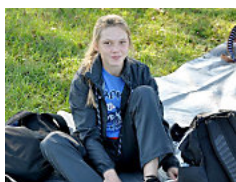

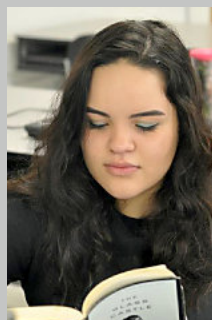

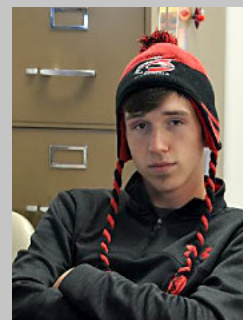
Chadwick Sweeps MTC Tournament

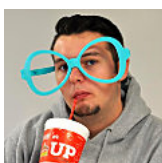

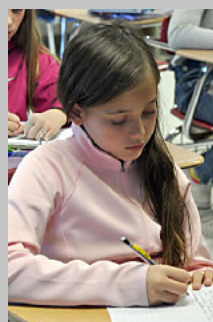

On February 21, the freshman class hosted a game night for boys and their mothers. There was music, food, and several activities, including Twister, musical chairs, and other games.

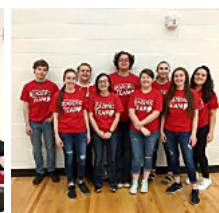

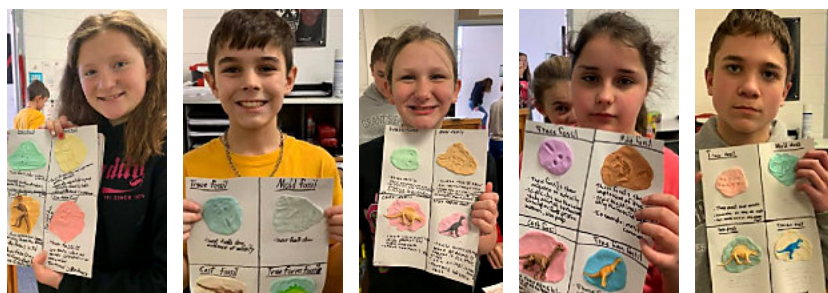


Green Eggs & Ham

So how did Chadwick students spend the weeks leading into their regularly scheduled summer break?



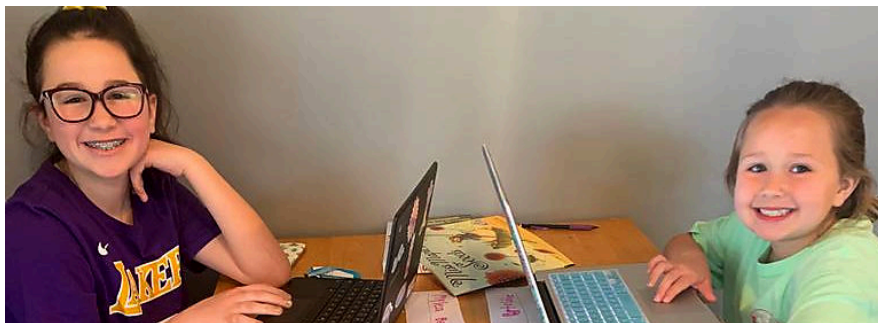
Many students took the extra time to get creative.
