



First day of school: Monday, August 24th

Chadwick Public Schools has created a comprehensive plan to provide a safe, secure environment for teaching and learning during the COVID-19 Pandemic. The information below explains our current guidelines for returning to school. Plans are subject to change as circumstances arise, and this guide will be updated with new information as it becomes available. Decisions will be made in coordination with local and state guidelines.

▶ Learning Options

- Option 1: Traditional in class learning 5 days per week with safety measures in place
- Option 2: On-line learning utilizing i-Ready curriculum with packets for some classes
- Option 3: Printed packets from i-Ready for students who do not have internet access

Students working from home will be held to the same standards as students seated at school. Failure to complete work will reflect on your grade.

Any student choosing to work from home must notify the school by August 14th.

▶ Health Services/PPE

- Parents are required to take temperatures and do a health assessment on their children before sending them to school. If your child has a fever of 100 degrees or higher, or any other symptoms, **Please keep them home.**
- Staff will be performing wellness assessments on themselves, as well.
- Use of personal masks will be allowed for students.
- Masks may be required in some situations especially for Middle/HS Students.
- Social distancing will be utilized to the extent possible.
- Hand sanitizer dispensers will be available throughout the building and frequent hand washing will be encouraged.

▶ Transportation

- Parents/Guardians will be encouraged to bring students to school.
- Seating assignments will be based on loading order and family.





▶ Arrival & Dismissal

- Parents/Guardians will not be allowed in the building before school.
- Parents/Guardians must remain in their vehicles when dropping off and picking up students.

▶ Breakfast & Lunch

- K-4 students who are not eating breakfast at school will go directly to their classroom. As students finish eating they will leave the cafeteria and go to their classroom.
- 5th-12th students who prefer a breakfast tray will eat in the cafeteria and then go to their designated area in the gym.
- Lunch will be limited to 2 grades per lunch period (with the exception of K, 1, & 2).

▶ Extended Safety Measures

- Visitors will not be allowed in the building during the school day.
- Hand sanitizer dispensers will be available throughout the building and frequent hand washing will be encouraged.
- Attendance incentives will be waived.
- Students who become sick with 2 or more symptoms will be sent home.
- Personal water bottles will be encouraged.
- Appropriate disinfecting products will be used to clean frequently touched surfaces.
- Students and Staff showing symptoms of COVID-19 may be required to provide a release from a health care provider before returning to school.
